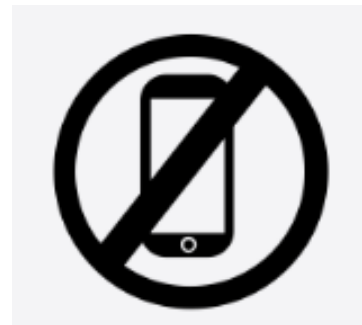


Friday 6th December
