Thank you to Miss Adams for putting on a wonderful Christmas sing up, the children were great!

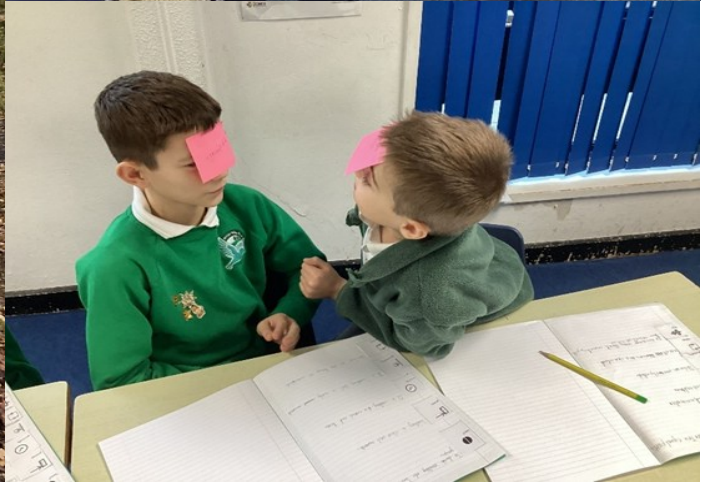
The Early Years Nativity!
